Initiatives taken by the institution in the Academic year 2022-2023

- In the Academic year 2022-23 classes are continuing in offline mode. However, if and when required G-suite can be used to conduct online classes and deliver lectures.
- Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) has been signed with Vijaygarh Jyotish Ray College and Raidighi College in addition to previous MOUs signed with New Alipore College and Muralidhar Girls' College.
- Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) has been signed with recycling and waste management service providers for proper disposal of waste.
- Procedure for RFID tagging of books with anti-theft stickers is still going on.
- KOHA software has been used for the automation of library.
- Digitisation of articles of the faculty members, prospectus etc., for developing the institutional repository by using the D-space software has been continuing.
- New method of online attendance has been started for students and teachers at the college library.
- Faculty members have attended UGC- Sponsored Faculty Induction Programmes, Refresher Courses and Short-term Courses on a regular basis during this year.
- Initiative for Career Advancement Scheme of teaching and non-teaching staff has been undertaken by the college.
- Academic Audit has been conducted.
- Mentor- Mentee system has been maintained
- Regular psychological counselling has been conducted.
