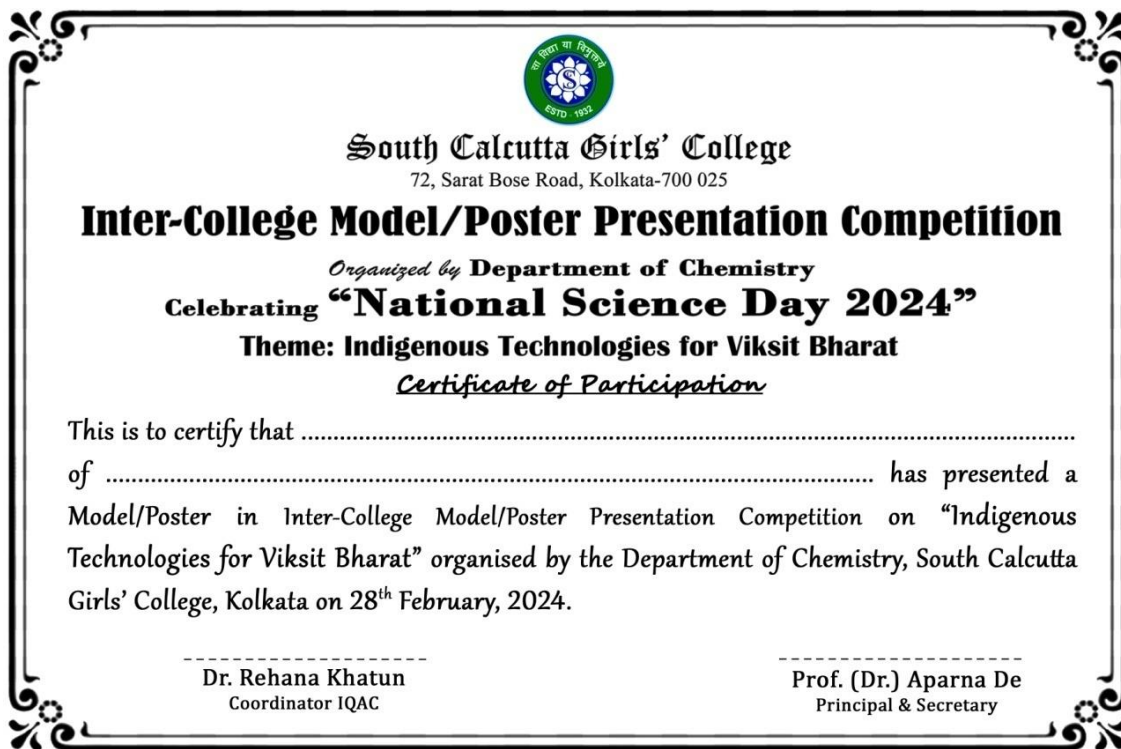
REPORT

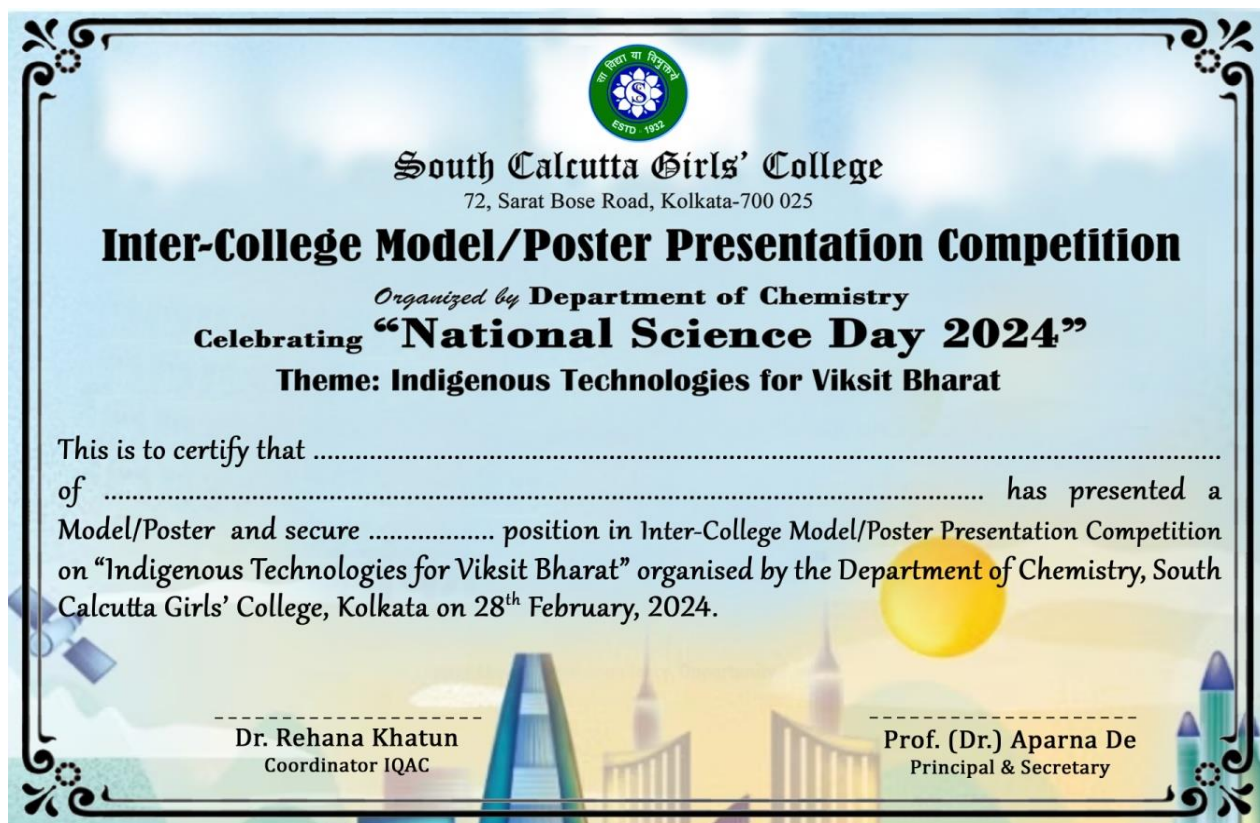

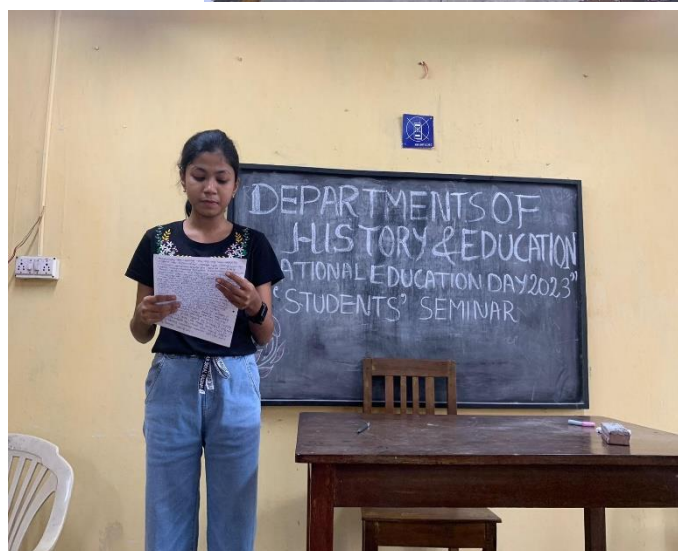

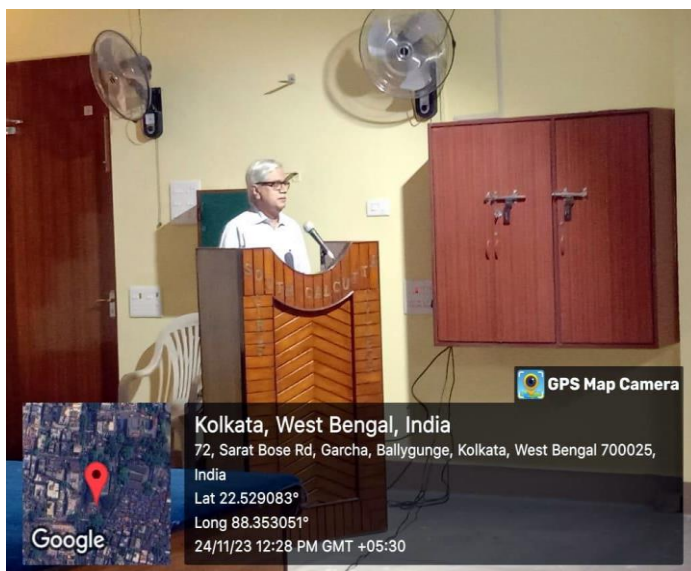

REPORT

A Seminar on “Philosophical Approaches to Peace: Gandhian and Tagore’s Perspectives” was organized on 24.11.2023 at 12 noon to commemorate World Philosophy Day. Soumitra Basu, Professor of Philosophy, Jadavpur University, Kolkata was the honourable speaker of the event. The lecture highlighted the basic ideas of Mahatma Gandhi and Rabindranath Tagore, both of whom had firm belief in the teachings of the Advaita Vedanta. They emphasised upon the human virtues of purity, honesty, respect and devotion. What is important is not what a person is but what he becomes, how he evolves through various phases in his life by conquering different barriers. Gandhi was a strong proponent of non-violence who preached and practised it against British colonial power. Non-violence is not a mere individual attitude towards life; it is a social virtue. Professor Basu mentioned that Rabindranath Tagore was critical of nationalism that breeds upon greed, power and fear. He supported the concept of internationalism that thrives on the qualities of love, communication and cooperation. Twenty-eight teachers and one hundred fifty-four students participated in the seminar. It was followed by a vibrant question and answer session where different questions came up like the inclusion of new inter-disciplinary paper in the new undergraduate philosophy syllabus and its relevance. Professor Basu tried to answer the questions clearly and briefly. His reference to the current warfare between Israel and Palestine made the discussion lively and interesting. Few teachers from adjacent colleges participated and certificates were given to them at the end of the seminar.
