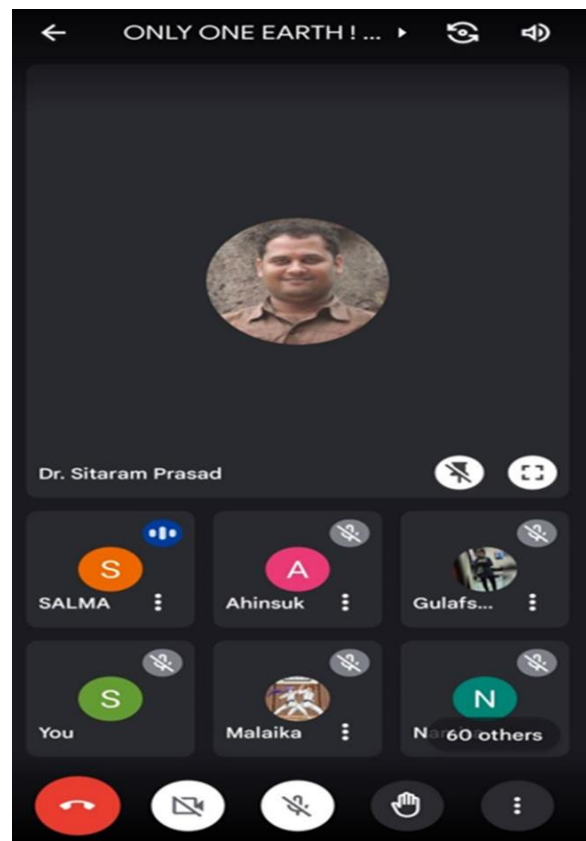
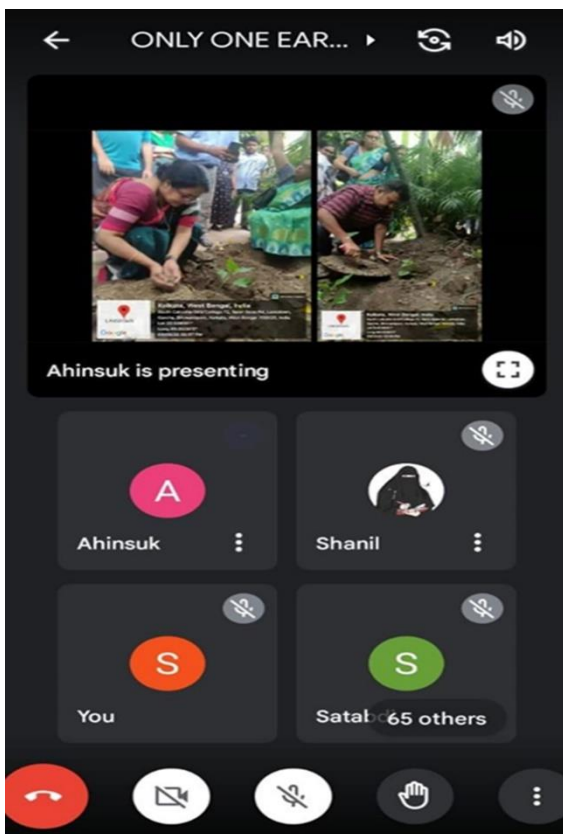
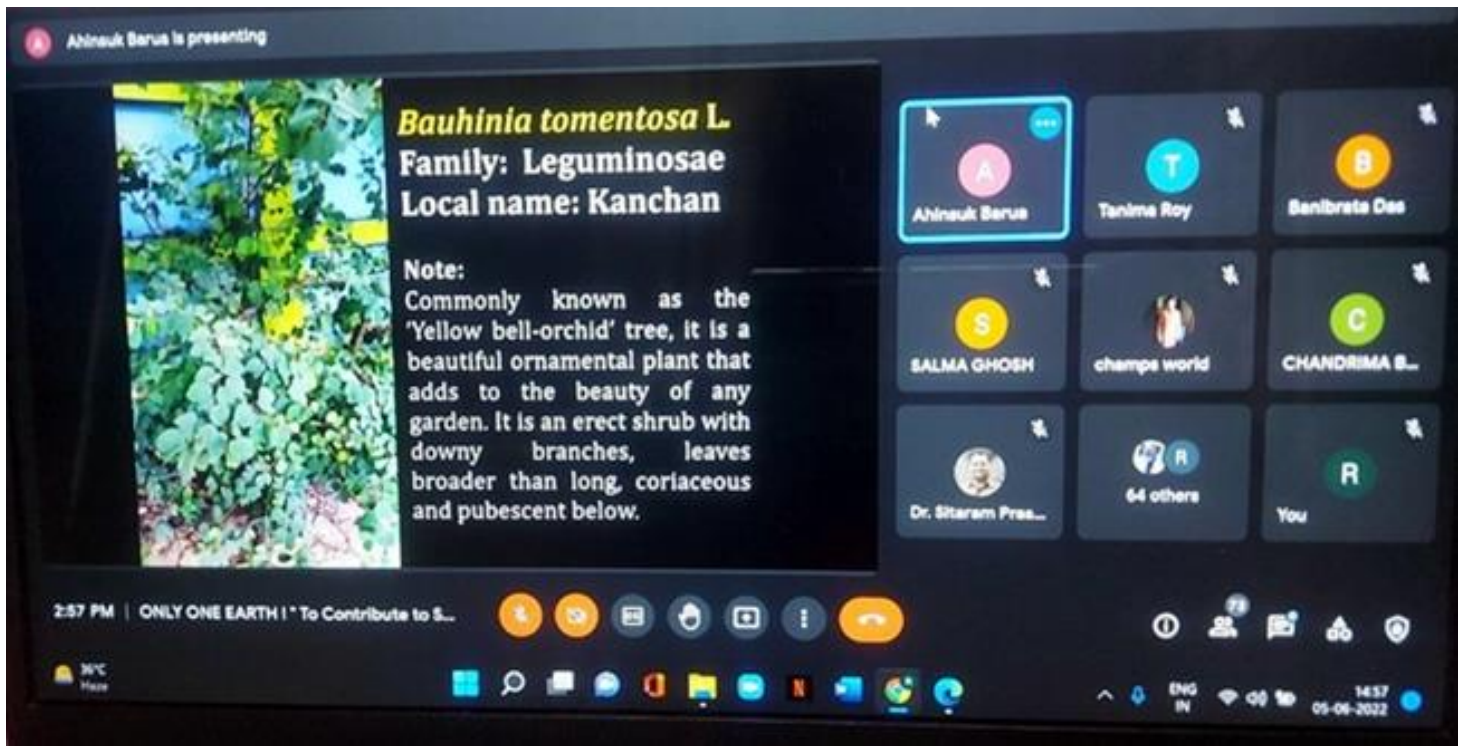

## REPORT

The Department of Botany along with the Eco Club organized an 'Awareness Programme' themed 'Only One Earth' on 05.06.2022 to celebrate the World Environment Day 2022. The program comprised two lecture sessions, one by Dr. Ahinsuk Barua, Assistant Professor and H.O.D. of Botany, South Calcutta Girls' College and the other by Dr. Sitaram Prasad Panda, Curator of Acharya Jagadish Chandra Bose Indian Botanic Garden, Botanical Survey of India, Shibpur, Howrah. The title of Dr. Barua's lecture was "Gems In Our Backyard- Floral Account of South Calcutta Girls' College Campus" while the title of Dr. Panda's lecture was "Socio-economic Importance of Orchids". The event was patronised by our honourable Principal, Prof. Dr. Aparna De and participated by approximately 73 participants. The entire program was conducted on the online platform organised by the college.

### SPEAKER: Dr. Sitaram Prasad Panda

Dr. Panda obtained his M.Sc. Life Science degree from Berhampur University of Odisha in 2002 and M.Phil. and Ph.D. degrees from Utkal University, Bhubaneswar, Odisha in 2004 and 2010 respectively. He has been working in the field of floristics and ethnobotany for the last two decades. Presently he is working as a Scientist 'C' and Garden Curator-in-charge in AJC Bose Indian Botanic Garden, Botanical Survey of India, Howrah. Dr. Panda is actively engaged in garden development and maintenance works as well as carried out collection and ex-situ conservation of Endemic, Endangered and Threatened (EET) Plants of the country. Previous to this, he had surveyed major forest rich areas of Eastern Ghats including Odisha for collection, identification and germplasm conservation of wild edible fruits and orchids and carried out their quantitative assessment. Vast experience in collection, identification and preservation of aquatic plants including mangroves and their associates of Odisha. Besides, compiled the aquatic flora of the largest fresh water lake of the state, Ansupa. Worked in all the major mangrove chunks of Odisha. Collected, identified, preserved (as herbarium samples) and conserved the germplasm of wild orchids of Eastern Ghats of India. Collected around 110 species of wild orchids from different forest areas of India and maintained their germplasm in the orchidarium of RPRC, Bhubaneswar. Worked as a herbarium keeper in the ICZM Project Odisha, under the State Wildlife Organisation of Odisha in the O/o PCCF (WL) and Chief WL Warden Odisha funded by World Bank and Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, New Delhi from 2012 to 2014. Pursued Taxonomy based research works like field survey, collection, identification and preservation of Angio spermic plants of Odisha coast in general and mangroves in particular. Prepared herbarium specimen of mangroves and developed of a small herbarium of plants of Bhitarkanika Wildlife Sanctuary in general and mangroves occurred there in particular. Worked as a Project Co-ordinator in Odisha Biodiversity Board under the Odisha Forest Department, Government of Odisha from 2014 to 2015 (31<sup>st</sup> April). Undertook the Biodiversity Management Committee (BMC) preparation work as well as preparation of Peoples Biodiversity Register (PBR). Arranged several training programmes in different part of Odisha for the frontline staff of Forest Department and BMC members on Biodiversity Act, 2002 and Rule 2004. Besides looked after all the official administrative works. He has published more than 70 research papers on national and international repute and authored 03 books. He has attended number of National and international symposiums and presented papers. He has made several new distributional records for states as well as for India.

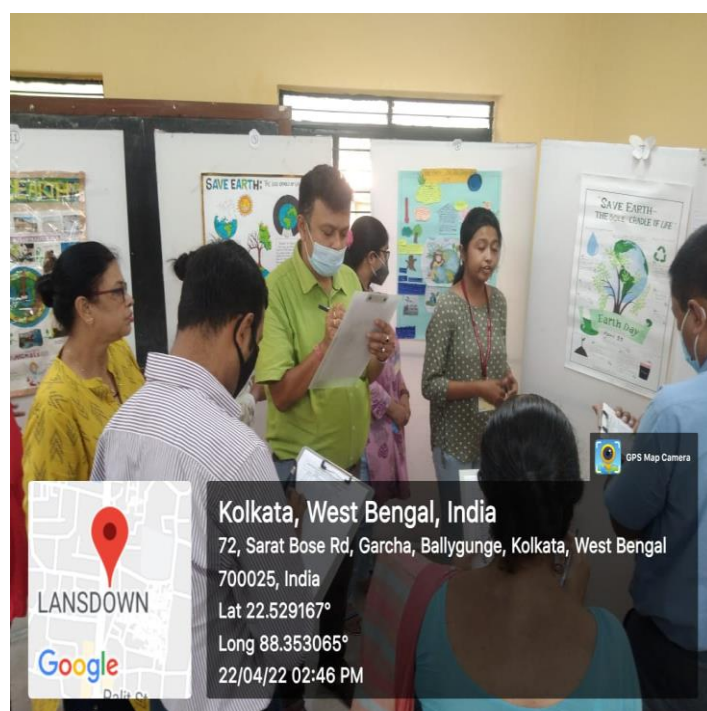
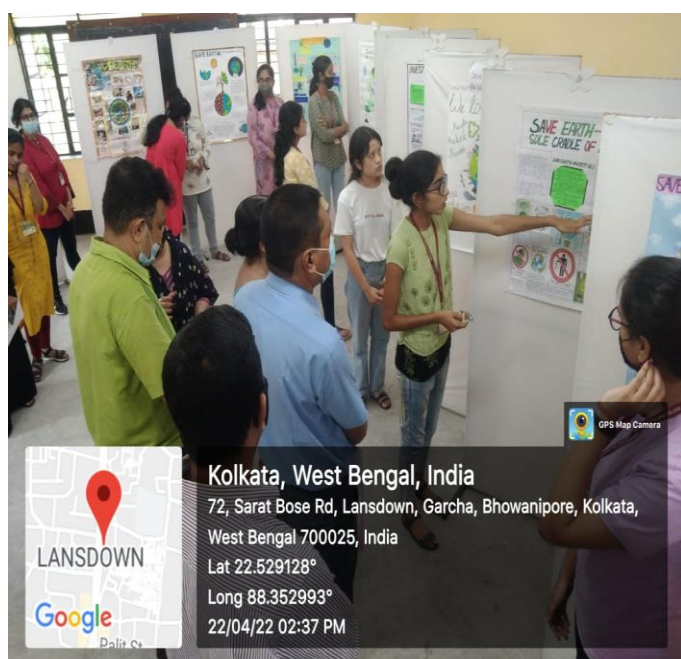

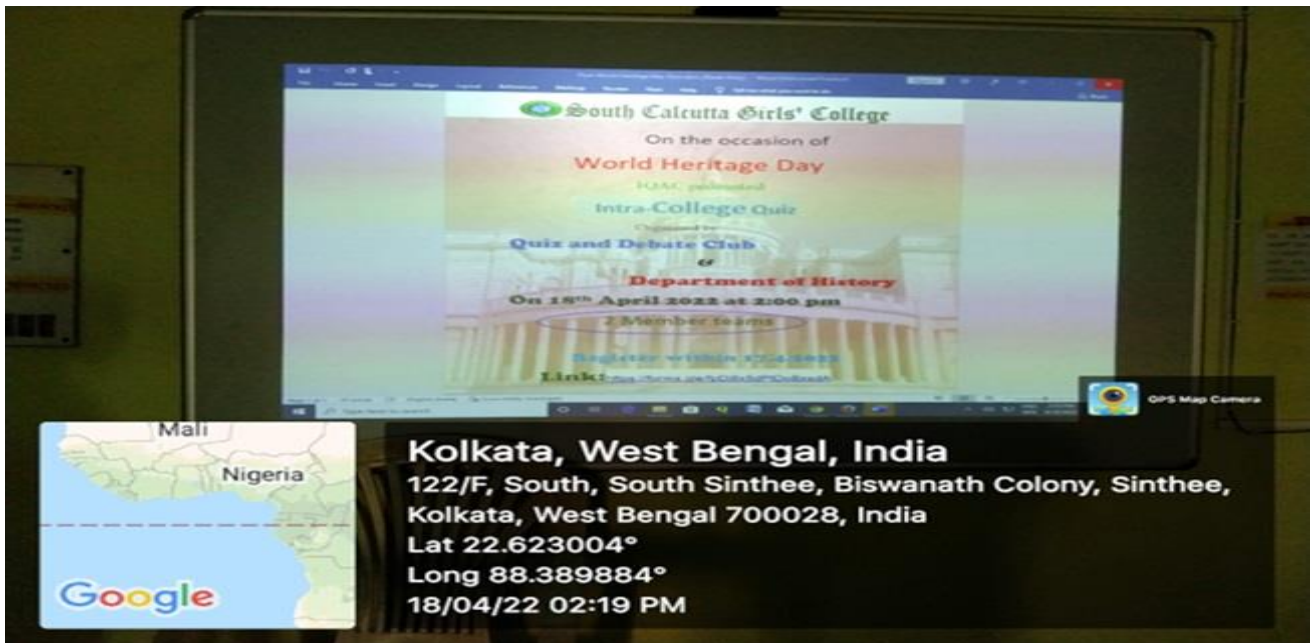


# REPORT

## **ORDERS RELATING TO THE NATIONAL ANTHEM OF INDIA**

The National Anthem of India is played or sung on various occasions. Instructions have been issued from time to time about the correct versions of the Anthem, the occasions on which these are to be played or sung, and about the need for paying respect to the anthem by observance of proper decorum on such occasions. The substance of these instructions has been embodied in this information sheet for general information and guidance.

### **I. THE NATIONAL ANTHEM - FULL AND SHORT VERSIONS**

- 1) The composition consisting of the words and music of the first stanza of the late poet Rabindra Nath Tagore's song known as "Jana Gana Mana" is the National Anthem of India. It reads as follows: -

Jana-gana-mana-adhinayaka jaya he  
Bharata-bhagya-vidhata  
Panjaba-Sindhu-Gujarata-Maratha  
Dravida-Utkala-Banga  
Vindhya-Himachala-Yamuna-Ganga  
uchchala-jaladhi-taranga  
Tava Subha name jage, tave subha asisa mage,  
gahe tava jaya-gatha.  
Jana-gana-mangala-dayaka jaya he  
Bharata-bhagya-vidhata.  
Jaya he, Jaya he, Jaya he,  
jaya jaya jaya jaya he.

The above is the full version of the Anthem and its playing time is approximately 52 seconds.

- (2) A short version consisting of the first and last lines of the National Anthem is also played on certain occasions. It reads as follows:

Jana-gana-mana-adhinayaka jaya he  
Bharata-bhagya-vidhata.  
Jaya he, jaya he, jaya he,  
Jaya jaya jaya jaya he.

Playing time of the short version is about 20 seconds.

- (3) The occasions on which the full versions or the short version will be played have been indicated at the appropriate places in these instructions.
