GENDER SENSITIZATION ACTION PLAN

Our College organises co-curricular and extra-curricular programmes related to gender-based concerns. Gender related themes are included in the syllabi of various disciplines. Webinars and paper/poster presentation competitions are organised on the issues of gender disparity and role of women in society.

Three programmes on these themes were held in 2020-21:

1. The Department of Bengali organised a student seminar on 21.9.2020 in the online mode on the topic “*Bangla SahityeNari*” (Women in Bengali Literature).
2. The Department of Economics held a poster competition on topic of “**Gender Equity and Sensitization**” on 13.5.2021.
3. An online inter college poster competition on the theme ‘**Challenges of Gender Discrimination**’ was organised by the NAAC Criterion 3 Committee, IQAC and NSS unit of South Calcutta Girls College on 25.6.2021.

Self-defence classes were also initiated in March 2020 for building self-confidence and self-discipline as well as improving health. Due to the pandemic, these classes could not be continued but they shall be started after classes on the College campus are allowed.

Vocational skill training is also conducted in College. A workshop in bandhni was organised in 2020-21 on the digital platform.

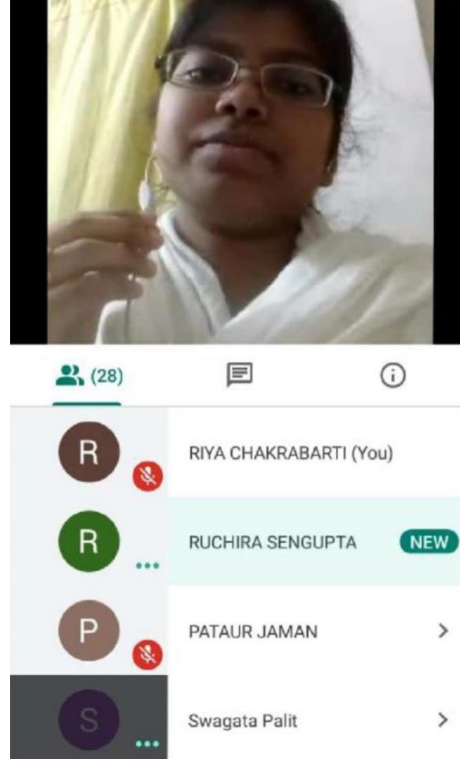
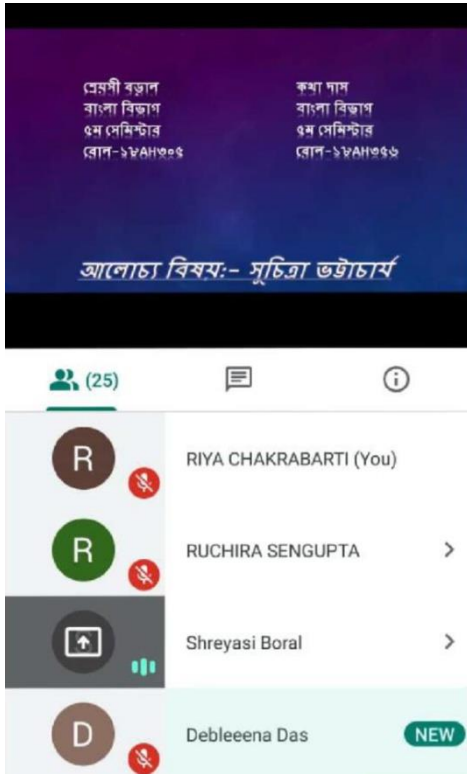

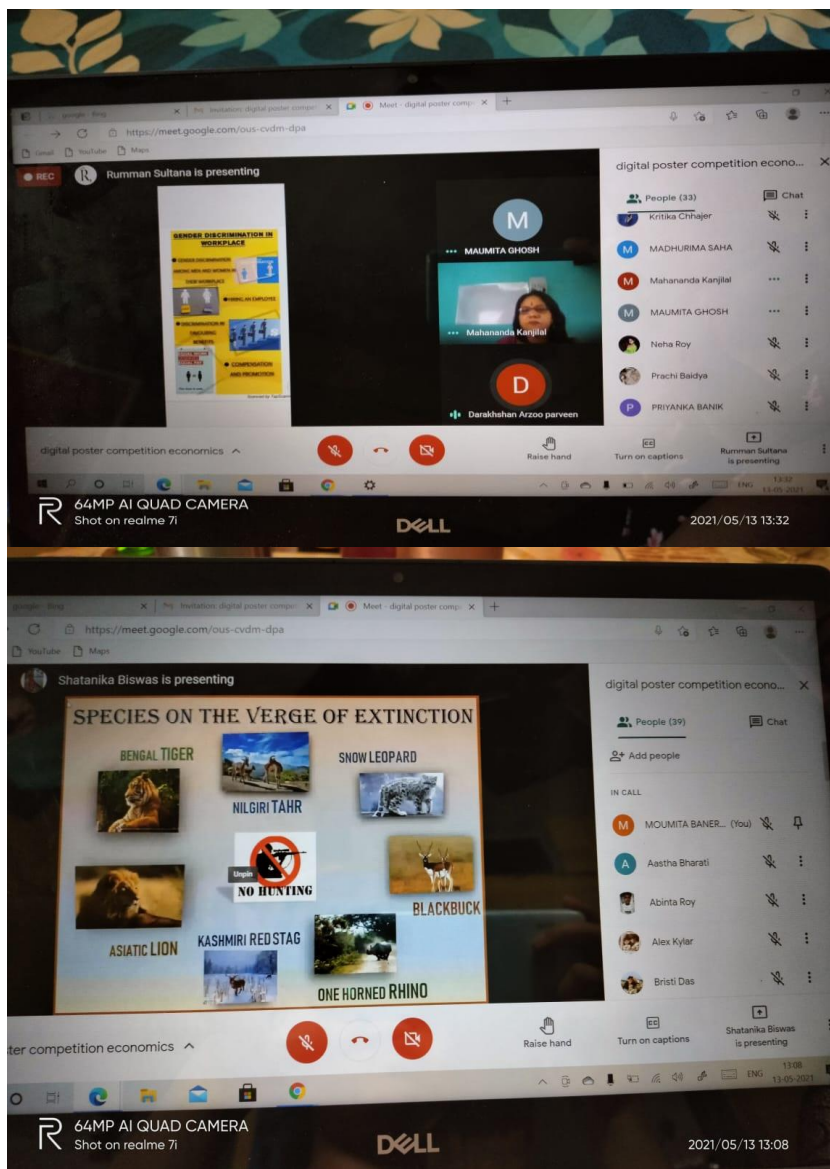
Ranking among the students was as follows:

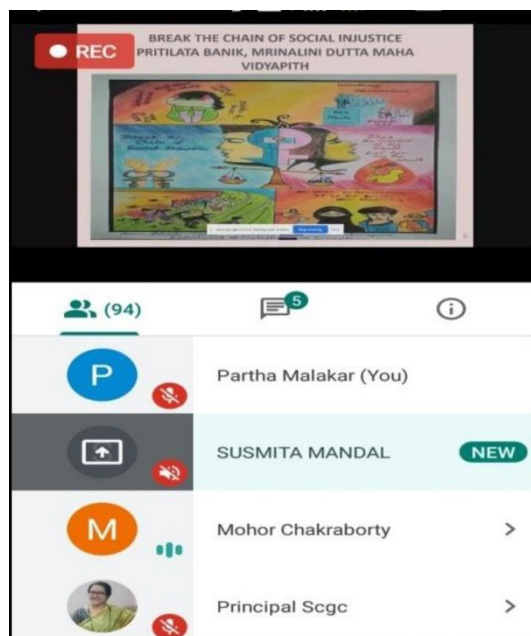
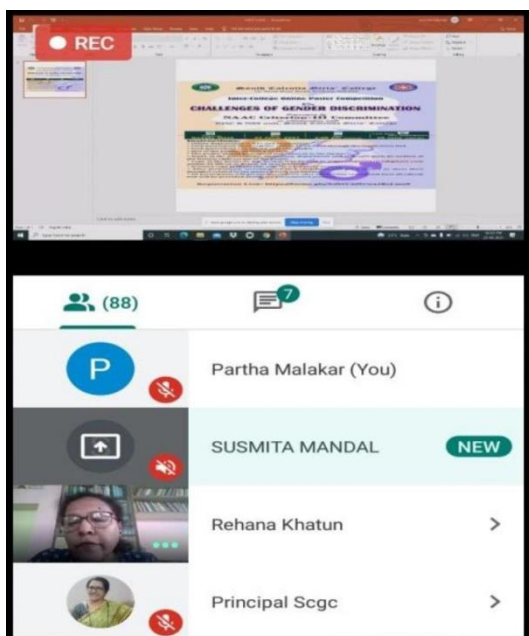
- * Online Registration is free and compulsory.

Our respected Principal, Prof. (Dr.) Aparna De, chaired the competition. The Competition commenced with the enlightening 'Welcome Address' of Principal Madam, which set the tone for the programme. Her address was followed by an illuminating speech by the Coordinator of IQAC and Associate Professor in Philosophy, Dr. Rehana Khatun. The Competition received an overwhelming response, which was very encouraging, given the pandemic situation. Students from over 60 educational institutions all over Kolkata submitted thought-provoking and innovative posters on this extremely relevant issue.
