Both these organizations will be hereafter referred to as Parties

II. Purpose of the Agreement

Both the Parties are pleased to enter upon an agreement to establish ties of academic cooperation in order to contribute to the achievement of their overall goals as institutions through following but not limited to:

1. Joint teaching and research projects.
2. Collaboration in the area of academic publications, research activities, field trips etc.
3. Visit, training and exchange of faculty, staff and students.
4. Joint educational/vocational courses.
5. Joint consultancy, PhD. supervision, scientific publications.
6. Co-hosting and participation in conferences, seminars, symposiums and workshops.
7. Social and cultural programs.
8. Any other activity that is mutually agreed upon and is beneficial to both.

III. Execution of the Agreement

The specific activities to be carried out under this agreement will be stated in corresponding specific sub-agreements. Such specific sub-agreements, once approved by both parties, will be attached as annexes to this agreement.

The specific sub-agreements between both Parties will specify their objectives, conditions and ways of execution, financial support, period the sub-agreement will be in effect, and administrative responsibility within each institution.

IV. Term and Expiration of the Agreement

It is understood that this agreement will come into effect after being signed by both Parties and will be established for a period of five years. After these five years it will be automatically extended for same period, unless one of the Parties expresses an intention (by written notification) to cancel the agreement at least 90 days before the expiry date. The amendment, termination and expiration of this MOU will no. affect the terms of activities ongoing at the time of notification of amendment, termination or expiration, unless otherwise agreed upon between the Parties.

Any additions, changes, or deletions to this document must be approved by the representatives of both Parties. All notices shall be in writing and shall be directed to these representatives.

V. NON-EXCLUSIVITY:

This Agreement is a non-exclusive agreement, and both parties remain free to enter into similar agreements with third parties.


VI. SPECIAL PROVISIONS

- b. All parties hereto shall do their utmost to ensure the smooth and efficient implementation of the programs.
- c. The parties will consult with each other for any subsequent associated agreement informally and attempt to resolve disputes or misunderstandings that may arise in the administration of this MOU or any subsequent associated agreement informally.
- d. Neither party can misuse this MOU by involving the name of the other without the written consent from the other party.
- e. There will be no financial involvement by neither of the party.


VII. DISPUTES

If any dispute arise in respect of the MOU, in that case both the organizations will discuss and settle the matter amicably.


Term of MoU:

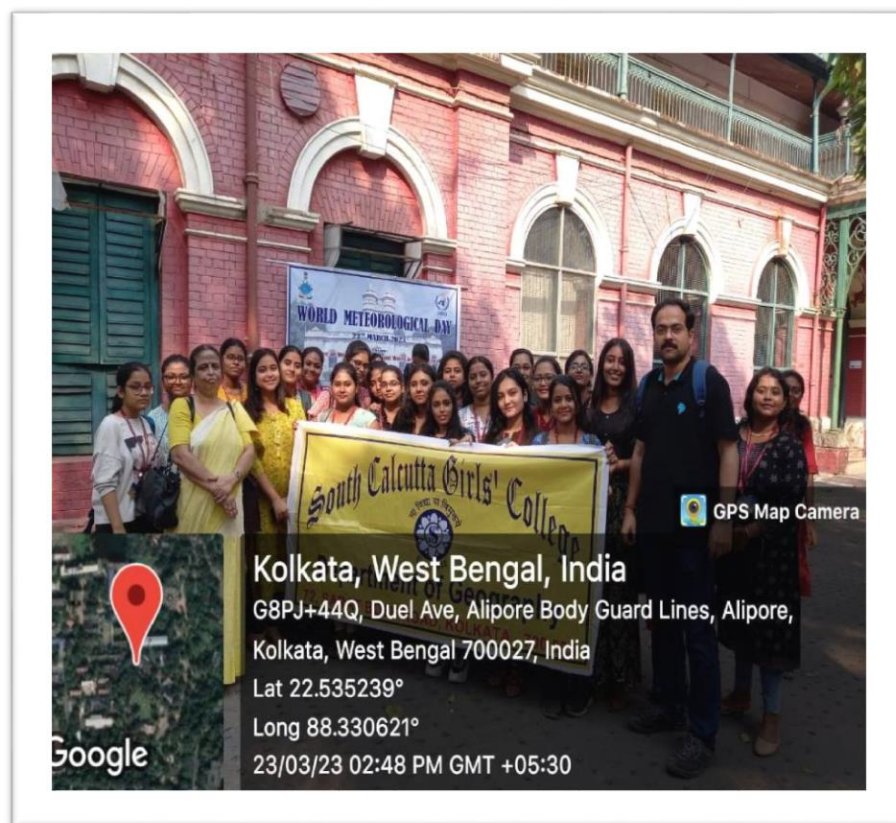

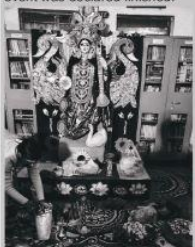

The report found a credentials gap of 26 percent for management jobs, 21 percent for computer and math jobs, and 13 percent for sales jobs. Saraswati Puja

New history is being created in UP:BJP

On March 10, States like Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand in the initial rounds of vote counting, it's leaders credited Prime Minister Narendra Modi's governance model for the expected win and said "new history" is being created in UP.

It is the first time in 37 years that a party ran a government for full five years in the largest and politically most important state that has been voted to power for a second consecutive term.

Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath led the BJP to victory after a high-decibel election campaign with thrust on the party's development at the agenda centre and in the state.

This is a major setback of win for BJP as UP is the most important state. BJP got new life with the ascent of Narendra Modi at it's top in 2014, is notching up achievements. With this round of elections, it has all but upended one of the last few

caveats to its spectacular success. BJP, continuously winning since 2014. The plans of Modi and Yogi is one of the big reason for the victory. With this victory and in terms of popularity, If Modi remains on same trajectory, will eventually overtake India's first Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru, who was elected to three terms.

All contentious measures undertaken over past several months and divisive statements made in the course of electoral campaign were endorsed by more than 41 percent of the people, which may be less than absolute majority but is enough in India's first-past-the-post electoral system to claim majority approval.

General Strike on 28th and 29th March 2022:BSNL

The two-day Bharat Bandh called for by a joint forum of trade unions to protest against the Centre's policies 'affecting workers, farmers and people' evoked mixed response across states with bank and transport services taking a hit in Delhi, West Bengal, Kerala and Tamil Nadu. The strike is set to have an impact on transport and banking services across the country. The All India Bank Employees Association has announced its support to the strike Prime Minister Narendra Modi's government says privatizing some state-owned banks would over haul the banking industry and that asset sales would help raise money to spur economic growth. The strike had little impact in India's capital, New Delhi, and the financial hub of Mumbai, but daily life

were expected to join the strike. West Bengal, in view of the nationwide strike call given by trade unions across the country on March 28 and 29, the West Bengal government on Saturday issued an order announcing that all state government offices will remain open and the employees will report to duty on these days. In a notification issued from state secretary Nabanna, Principal Secretary Manoj Pant said that any employee remaining absent for two days or either of the days without permission shall be asked for an explanation. 'In view of a call given by different trade

unions and others for a 48-hour nationwide strike on 28th and 29th March, 2022, it has been decided that all state government offices shall remain open and all the employees shall report for duty on those days. It has been decided that no casual leave or any other leave for absence either in the first half or in the second half or for the whole day shall be granted to any employee on the above-mentioned dates," the notification said. The government said leaves will be treated as 'dies non' and no salary will be admissible. Earlier this week, a joint forum of central trade unions had given a call for a nationwide strike in protest against the central government's policies affecting workers, farmers, and people. 'All Heads of Offices/Controlling Authorities concerned will issue Show-Cause notice to the employee(s) concerned, who will remain absent on March 28, 2022 and March 29, 2022 or on any of these 2 (two) dates, asking him/her to explain why action would not be taken against him/her for such unauthorised absence. On receipt of satisfactory reply, leave due and admissible may be granted on production of documentary evidence on the grounds mentioned above," it said. Those not responding to the show-cause notice shall be liable to disciplinary action, the notification said.

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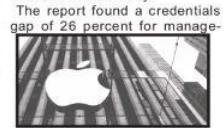

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End of Kohli's era in T20 Captaincy



Virat Kohli on Thursday announced he will step down as India's T20 captain after the T20 World Cup in UAE but will continue to lead the side in ODIs and Test cricket. "I've decided to step down as the T20 captain after this T20 World Cup in Dubai in October," Kohli said in a statement posted on his Twitter page.

Virat Kohli's announcement that he will relinquish the Indian T20I captaincy after the ongoing ICC T20I World Cup was made roughly a month before the tournament began. And that surprised a lot of people who are part of the cricketing fraternity and many outside it as well. Former cricketers like Maninder Singh and Monty Panesar feel that the decision by the Indian skipper, that to head of a big tournament, didn't send a positive message and possibly affected Team India's performance in the mega tournament.

"I don't want to blame Virat here. There are some players who were thinking that they want to replace Virat as the next captain. Virat made a big mistake announcing the decision ahead of the tournament that he will be giving up his T20I captaincy after the World Cup. He should have played the tournament and then at the end of the tournament, whatever India's result was, announced that - I am quitting T20I captaincy. Things would have been different today if Virat had done this," Panesar told in an exclusive interview.

Former India cricketer Maninder Singh heaped praise on Virat's achievements but criticised his decision of announcing his decision to quit as T20I captain ahead of a tournament like the World Cup. "The disappointment will always be there with Virat. He is such a player who always performed and won matches for India and always finished on a high. But before the T20 World Cup, a captain comes and says this is going to be my last tournament as T20I captain. Okay, we accept that. And our coach also comes, whether he has been told or he doesn't want to continue and speaks about his last assignment. This doesn't give a positive message. Now, what is happening? A lot of things created confusion basically and this will always have an effect on the performance. And it has happened," Maninder signed off.

Kohli said that his captaincy relinquishing decision was welcomed by the BCCI and he wasn't told to reconsider his decision and it was taken as a progressive step in the right direction India captain.
