1. The salient features of Phylum Porifera:

- a) Aquatic, sessile animals organisms which occur singly or in colonies
- b) The body consists of innumerable pores
- c) They possess a canal system which helps in transporting food and oxygen
- d) The inner side of the body is lined by flagellated cells called Choanocytes, which help in water circulation and feeding.

2. Fresh water sponge - Spongilla  
Marine sponge - Halichondria

3. In Ascon type canal system, the body organization is ~~very~~ is the simplest with no ~~branched~~ branched canals.

In Sycon type canal system, the body organization is much more complex than in Asconoid canal system. Syconoid sponges have a row of tiny chambers called radial canals.

4. The 5 system classification states living things are classified into five kingdoms -

• Monera • Protista • Fungi • Plantae • Animalia.

The propounder is Whittaker.

5. Characteristic features of Phylum Platyhelminthes :-

- They are triploblastic acoelomate. They have organ systems in the middle layer.
- Soft bodied with protective mucous secretion. Few species have internal spicules.
- Digestive system has a single opening. Anus is absent.
- Circulatory and respiratory organs are absent. Gaseous exchange takes place by diffusion.
