Objectives:-

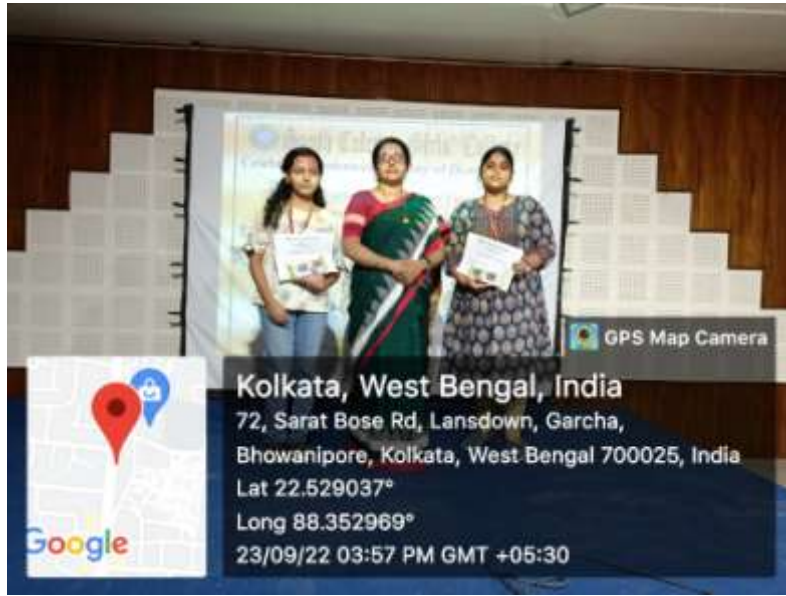
- ❖ To promote physical, mental, emotional, intellectual and spiritual upliftment of the student community

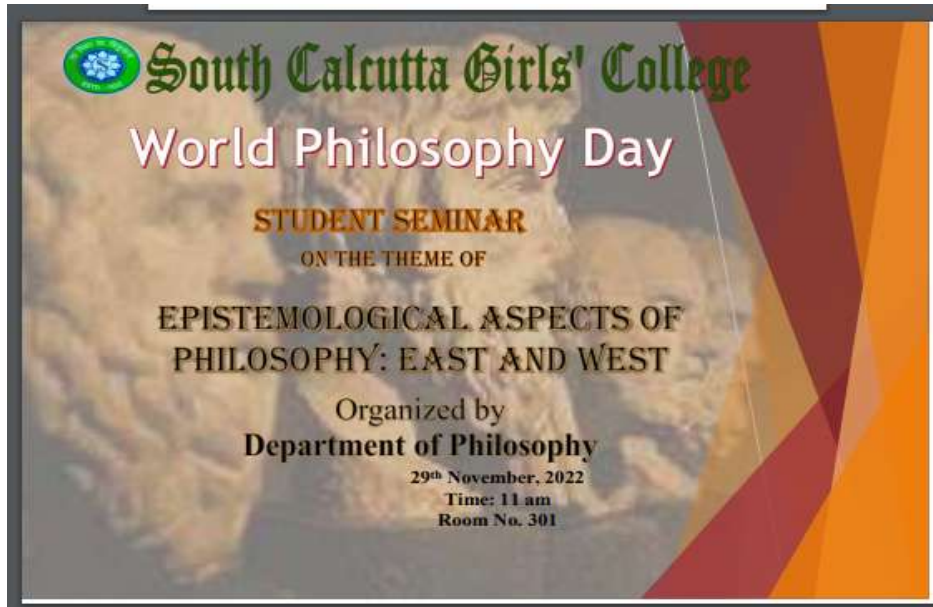

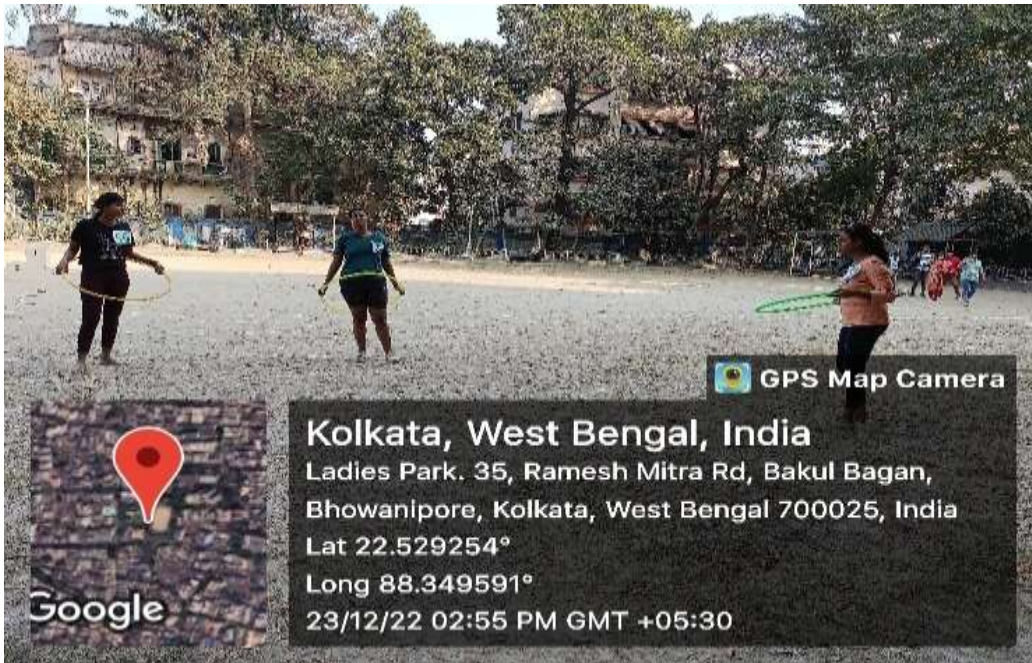
