


METRIC POINT 7.1.3 AQAR 2021-22 SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT MOU WITH REDVIVUS RECYCLERS LIMITED FOR SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT



WHEREAS

- 'The Seller' is an undergraduate college affiliated with the University of Calcuttain Kolkata, West Bengal.
- 'The Buyer' is engaged in providing Recycling and Waste Management services for dry recyclables such as Plastic, Metal and E-waste in India.
- The Buyer approached The Seller to provide recycling and allied waste management services
 for its premises in Kolkata and The Seller agreed to appoint The Buyer for providing the
 aforementioned services on the following terms and conditions as set herein.

NOW THE PARTIES MENTIONED HEREIN HAVE WITNESSETH AND HEREBY DECLARE, UNDERTAKE AND AGREE AS UNDER:

ARTICLE-1 DEFINITIONS

- Unless otherwise clearly required by the context, the following terms shall have the respective meanings as defined below:
 - "Collection Staff" shall mean employees/staff of The Buyer responsible for packaging and collection of Recyclables.
 - "Main Storage Location" shall mean storage location where all the Dry Recyclables
 will be stored for collection and this location should be accessible to collection
 vehicle of The Buyer.
 - "Recyclables" means any type of dry waste (Non-Hazardous) which is not contaminated and can be reused or recycled into a new product.

- "Recycle Points" means points awarded by The Buyer for per kg of Recyclables.
 1 Recycle Point = 1.00 INR.
- "Collection Site" shall be at 72, Sarat Bose RD, Garcha, Ballygunge, Kolkata, West Bengal 700025.

ARTICLE-2 APPOINTMENT OF THE BUYER

- 2.1 The Seller hereby appointed The Buyer to provide the recycling and allied waste management services for its Collection Site.
- 2.2 The Buyer will collect the dry recyclables from the premises of The Seller as per the terms and conditions mentioned in this MOU.

ARTICLE-3

RECYCLING PROGRAMME

- 3.1 The Seller will collect all the Dry Recyclables in main storage location within the premises.
- 3.2 After collection of minimum quantity of 300kg Recyclables, the representative of The Seller shall intimate to The Buyer to collect Recyclables and to initiate the Recycling Program.
- 3.3 After expiry of first 1 (one) month from the date of first collection, The Buyer will decide the collection frequency of future collections with mutual discussion with **The Seller**.
- 3.4 After finalization of the collection frequency, Collection Staff of The Buyer will call the The Seller and check the collection requirement of Recyclables.
- 3.5 Collection Staff of The Buyer will collect the Recyclables from the premises of The Seller after getting the collection requirement from the office of The Seller on next day or within 3 working days from the receipt of collection request from the office of The Seller.
- 3.6 Collections are performed on working days i.e., Monday to Saturday at every week between 10.00 am to 7.00 pm except public holidays.

5.3 All Recycle Points shall be tried to be redeemed in the same financial year (April to March).

ARTICLE-6 MISCELLANEOUS

- 6.1 This MOU, its existence and all information exchanged between the Parties under this MOU shall not be disclosed to any Person by any Party. Each Party shall hold in strictest confidence, shall not use or disclose to any third party, and shall take all necessary precautions to secure any Confidential Information of the other Party. Disclosure of such information shall be restricted solely to employees, agents, consultants and representatives who have been advised of their obligation with respect to Confidential Information. The obligations of confidentiality do not extend to information which:
 - a. is disclosed to employees, legal advisers, auditors and other consultants of a Party provided such persons have entered into confidentiality obligations similar to those set forth herein; or
 - b. is disclosed with the consent of the Party who supplied the information; or
 - c. is, at the date this MOU is entered into, lawfully in the possession of the recipient of the information through sources other than the Party who supplied the information; or
 - d. is required to be disclosed pursuant to applicable law or is appropriate in connection with any necessary or desirable intimation to the Government of India;
 or
 - e. is generally and publicly available, other than as a result of breach of confidentiality by the Person receiving the information.
 - 6.2. The Parties acknowledge and agree that this MOU is effective as of date of execution of this MOU and shall be valid from the effective Date until terminated by any of the party by giving 30 days written notice to other party.
 - 6.3 Any notice required or permitted to be given hereunder shall be in writing and shall be effectively served (i) if delivered personally, upon receipt by the other Party; (ii) if sent by prepaid courier service, airmail or registered mail, within five (5) days of being sent; or (iii) if sent by facsimile or other similar means of electronic communication (with confirmed receipt), upon receipt of transmission notice by the server the server and the confirmed receipt.




FACILITIES FOR SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

PIT FOR CHEMICAL WASTE






NSS PROGRAMME FOR THE SESSION 2021-2022


