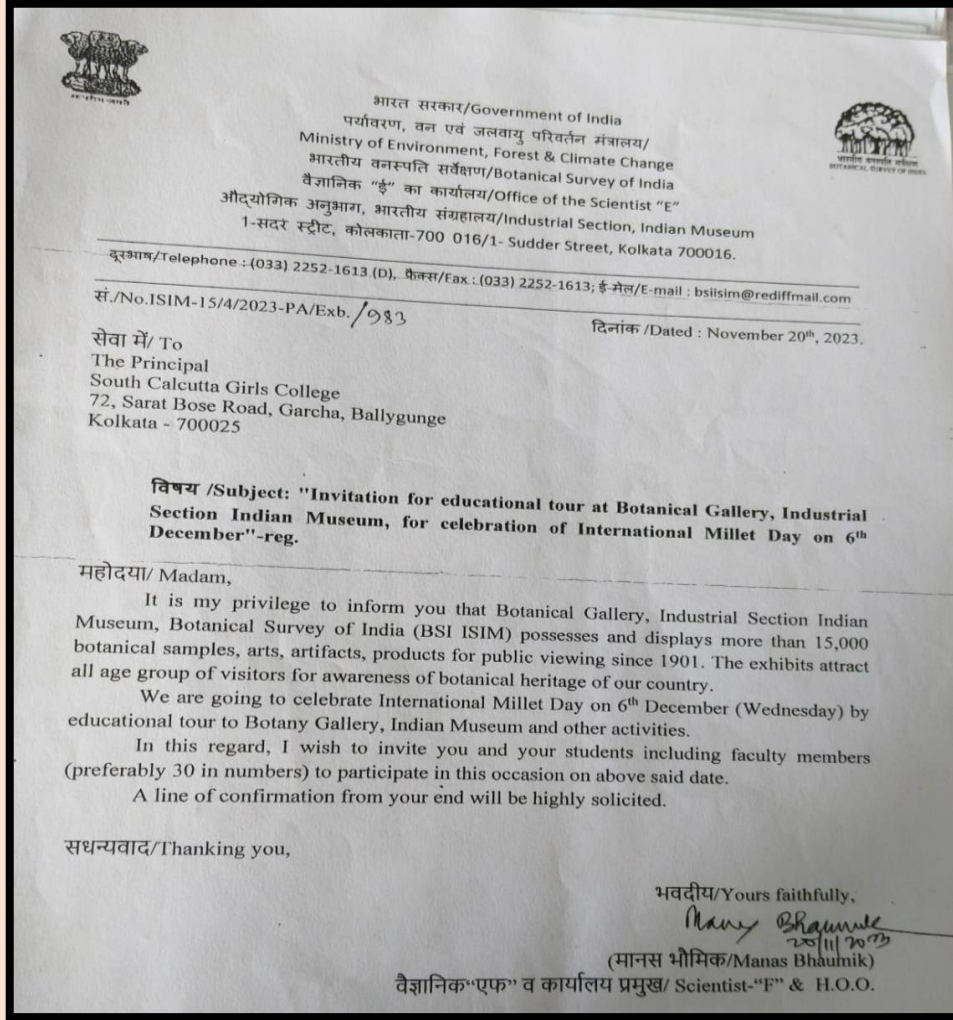

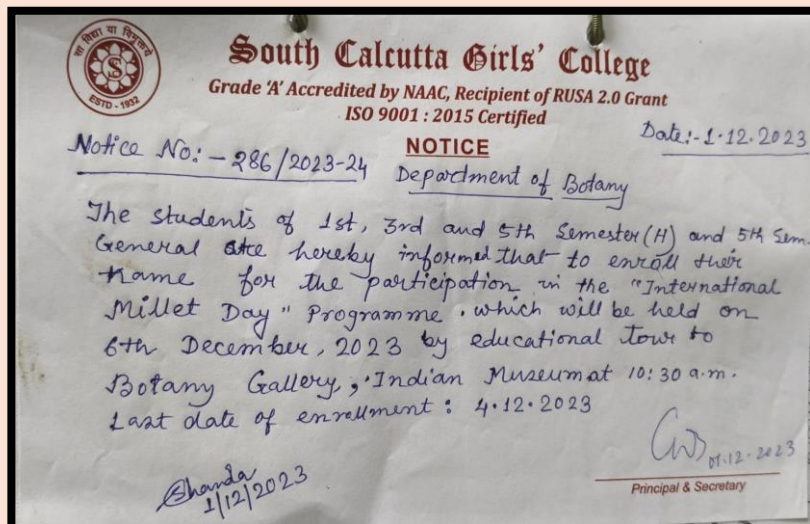

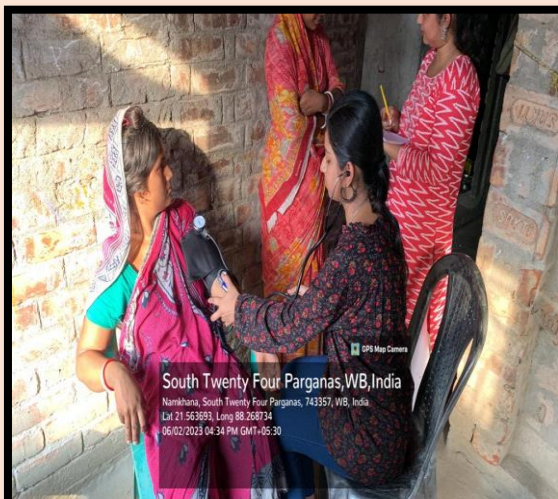

This may due to working for a long time in an awkward posture, which affects the body especially lower back and knee. The most of the villagers are suffering from Gout, Diabetes and Respiratory trouble with a low blood pressure level.



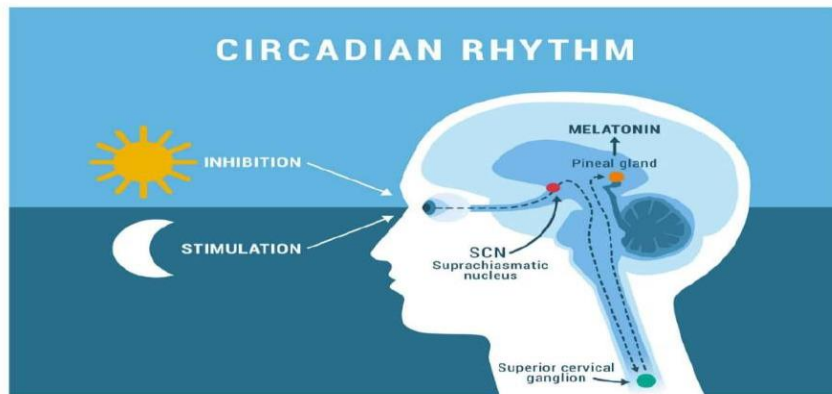

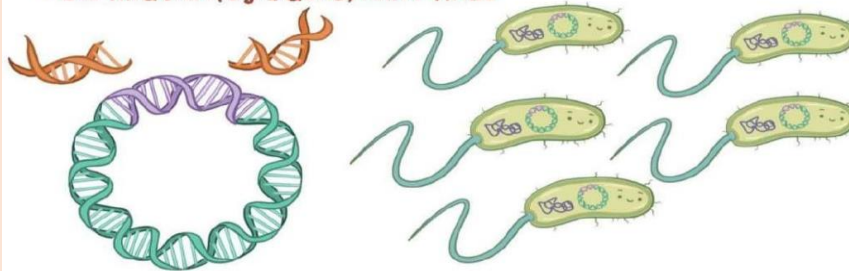
