Introduction

The Zoological Garden, Alipore (the Alipore Zoo or Calcutta Zoo) is India's oldest formally stated zoological park and a big tourist attraction in Kolkata, West Bengal. It has been open as a zoo since 1876, and covers 18.811 hectare (46.48 acres). Total 1266 number of animals belonging to 108 species are there in Alipore Zoo.

Purpose


- 1. The zoo remains one of the most popular tourist attractions in Kolkata.
- 2.The zoo displays a large number of crowd pulling mega fauna including the royal bengal tiger, white tiger, crocodyle, African lion, Jaguars, Hippopotamus, One horned Rhinoceros, Giraffe, Zebra, Emu, Indian Elephant and Hippopotamus
- 3. It is also known to be the home to one of the few captive breeding projects involving Manipur brow antlered deer.

Outcome of visits

1.We saw a large number of animals like *Naja* sp. *Gekko* sp.*Crocodylus* sp.*Struthio* sp.*Pavo* sp.*Cygus* sp. *Pan* sp.*Eqquas* sp. *Hyaena*, *Panthera leo.Panthera tigris*, *Giraffa sp* and *Elephas* sp.

- 2.The Alipore Zoo was among the first zoos in the world to breed white tigers and the common reticulated Giraffe.
- 3.Breeding programme of the Manipur brow antlered deer in The Alipore Zoo has been brought back from the brink of extinction.

4.It is the home for wintering migratory birds like swan, crane, stork etc.









History Department Virtual tours in 2020-21

In Semester III History Hons SEC A1 course, visit to museums and archives is an integral part of the course. A virtual tour of the Indian Museum, Kolkata and the National Museum, New Delhi was organised in class. Students are required to write a report on the tour in their theory examination.

In Semester IV History Hons, SEC B2 course on Art Appreciation, exposure to Indian art through visuals, and visits to sites and museums has been recommended. Virtual tours of important heritage sites, such as the Sanchi Stupa, Ajanta Caves, temples of the Gupta period, the Red Fort, Humayun's tomb, Fatehpur Sikri were arranged. Documentaries on sculpture and paintings of the modern era were shown to the students in class. These helped them to get an overview of the monuments and develop an understanding of the art forms and architectural details.







- * All registered students will get the e-certificate after submission of feedback form (feedback link will be provided during the power point session).




Total number of participants: 22






